8:15 - 8:30 AM

MORNING DROP-OFF

Students arrive, ready to kick start their day in a focused and engaging environment.

8:45 - 9:00 AM

MORNING LAUNCH

The day begins with a motivational activity to energize and inspire students to jump into their learning tasks ahead.

9:00 - 11:30 AM

2 HOUR LEARNING

Using our Al-powered 2 Hour Learning platform, students engage in 30-minute blocks dedicated to core academic subjects: Math, Science, English, and Social Studies. This app-based learning is driven by Alpowered learning tools that adapt to each student's pace, ensuring mastery of the material 2-5x faster than traditional methods.

10:15 - 10:30 AM

SNACK/OUTDOOR RECESS

A short break is included to refresh and recharge, allowing students to return to their studies with renewed focus.

11:30 - 12:30 PM

LUNCH/RECESS

Students enjoy lunch and free time, with exact times staggered by age/grade to provide the best experience for all.

12:30 - 3:15 PM

WORKSHOP TIME

For the afternoon, the focus shifts to developing Limitless Life Skills through a variety of engaging, hands-on workshops. These sessions are designed to equip students with essential skills such as learning how to ride a bike, hosting your own news broadcast, completing a Spartan Race, and even building an Olympic-level final project!

What is a Workshop?

Workshops focus on teaching students curated skills like public speaking, coding, entrepreneurship and leadership. All workshops culminate in a community event, called Test2Pass, where students showcase the life skills they have learned to their parents in a student-run demonstration. Here are some examples of the social, interactive, creative, and limitless growth we facilitate in workshops.

Pedal Power (K-1st)

"Pedal Power" empowers students to gain confidence and independence on a bike, whether they're new or experienced riders. Through fun and safety, they'll master the skills needed to ride on their own.

Test2Pass:

Bike 5 miles solo without stopping!

Alpha News Network (2nd Grade)

Students develop public speaking skills by delivering live news broadcasts in front of the whole school. They'll learn to engage audiences, using body language, voice projection, and clear communication.

Test2Pass: Present the Alpha News at 120-170 wpm with energy, assessed via Orai.

Financial Frontier (3rd/4th Grade)

In "Financial Frontier," students navigate realworld financial scenarios using ClassBank, learning to manage money, set savings goals, and understand financial autonomy.

Test2Pass:

Create and present a personal financial plan, including earnings targets, savings goals, and spending habits.

Dream Launcher (7th/8th Grade)

Students embark on a journey of self-discovery, exploring their passions and creating a roadmap for the future. They'll craft a personal "Spiky POV" and financial plan for a long-term project.

Test2Pass: Create a Genesis Project one-liner approved by Alpha High and outline a 10-year financial plan.

Spartan Race (5th/6th Grade)

This workshop teaches teamwork and resilience as students tackle and overcome a challenging Spartan Race course together, learning the power of collaboration.

Test2Pass: Complete all race obstacles as a team and cross the finish line together.
